Mark Making – Line Quality

On paper made in the cinquecento method



Papermaking inspired by Italian handmade papers of the cinquecento

Furnish:


- Composted linen and hemp rags/fiber, cooked in soda ash
- Sun bleached 3% hydrogen peroxide and sunlight
- Additives: Calcium carbonate, magnesium carbonate, titanium dioxide


Process

- Handmade using antique paper moulds 18 x 14 in. and 22 x 32 in.
 Pressed between coarse felts (outer coat Navajo-Churro wool) Pressure: 50 tons
- Air dried, unconstrained
- Hide glue, tub-sized at 135° (rabbit skin and alum) pH 6 pressed to 1 ton


Finish:

• Cold pressed preserving felt hair marks







Graphite – Mechanical Pencil HB




Ink - Quill pen








Graphite – Berol Draughting 314
